## Putnam PSD Wins Two Statewide Awards

Canaan Valley, WV – Putnam Public Service District was honored with two major awards in the field of water quality at the 2010 American Water Works Association-West Virginia Section’s annual conference banquet held on May 25, 2010.

In the annual taste test competition, Putnam PSD bested 16 other water systems from throughout the state. The judges rated the water quality based on factors such as appearance, odor, flavor, mouthfeel, and aftertaste. Our unique watershed and large reservoir gives us an optimum quality source-water.
